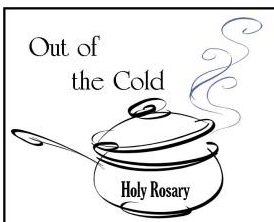
Thank You From All Of Us!

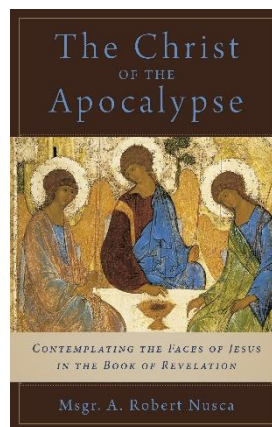
