Prayer and Quiet Reflection

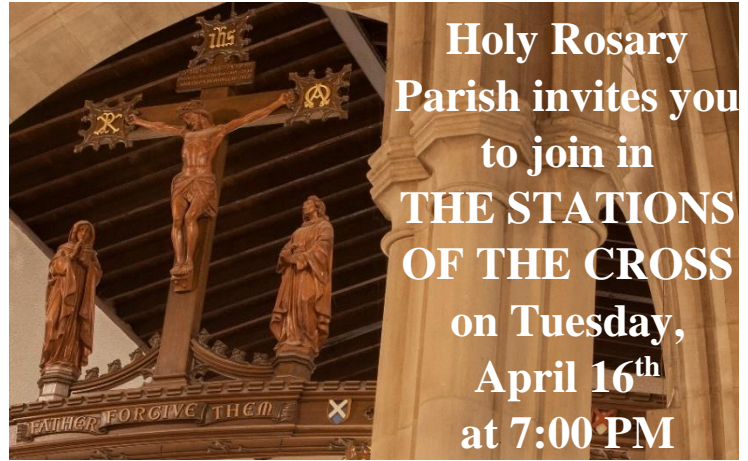

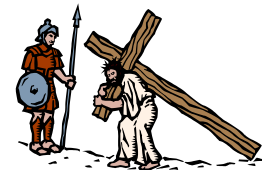
