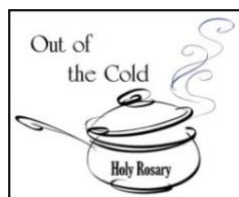


VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

The Province of Ontario has declared a *state of emergency* in the effort to limit the spread of the **Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic**. The *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act* is being invoked by the Province to enforce a ban - effective until **March 31st, 2020** - upon **all organized gatherings of over 50 people**. This **includes services within places of worship**.

For this reason, Cardinal Collins has asked that during this medical emergency, beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020, that all **public Masses be canceled, both during the week and on the weekend**.
