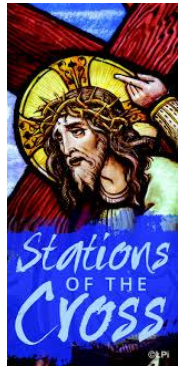
March 28/29 – SHARELIFE SUNDAY

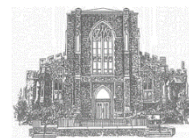
