2020 Tax Receipts

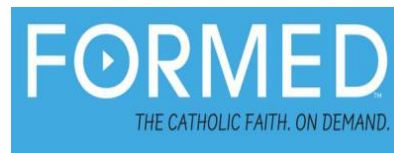
Due to the pandemic, this year, the Archdiocese of Toronto will be mailing out your tax receipts on the 23rd of February 2021. You should
