

Church Landscaping on Tweedsmuir: Update



The Building Committee reported a few weeks ago about what we plan

to do about the dead and dying hedge on the Tweedsmuir side of the church and that this work has been delayed by the City's project to rebuild the road and widen the sidewalks. Initially, they advised us that this would involve the destruction of the hedge along the length of Tweedsmuir. With the help of John Rossetti and Councillor Josh Matlow's office, we have been able to negotiate a new arrangement with the City which should preserve the majority of the hedge. Where the hedge is dead, we will replace it with an attractive steel fence. This is the good news; the not-so-good news is that this cannot happen until the City has completed its construction, likely next Spring. In the meantime, we will cut down the dead hedge plants. We are really grateful for the Councillor's intervention which made this possible.
