

- 4. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul will be speaking at all the Masses this weekend, December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>t</sup> Please see below for a message from them:

"The pandemic has affected all of us in one way or another. It caused a major negative impact on our work with the most vulnerable in our community.

We could NOT visit our neighbours in need but continued our outreach by phone calls, and mailing out food cards. Our clients were so appreciative, because so many of them were alone. We respond to over sixty

calls per month to people desperately in need of help. This number will go up over 100 during the Christmas season. Families are facing tough times, high cost of groceries and paying the rent has become more and more difficult. Our single neighbours are facing the same challenges, then mix in mental illness and addictions and the future looks bleak. We are now able to resume home visits, and provide in person fellowship and financial support. Each month we deliver between \$4000. - \$5000. worth of food cards. Unfortunately we are now in a position that we will have to scale back our ministry due to lack of funds. The church was closed for a long period of time and then only to limited numbers. Then came the realization we now had no income from the poor boxes, and no fundraising in three years.

We are begging you today to help us financially to continue our good works.

There are three ways to help SSVP HR:

- If you are in a position to make a sizable donation it would be greatly appreciated and of course you will receive a tax receipt.
- We are selling Christmas gift cards after all the masses this weekend, December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>
- There is a Giving Tree in the Church and it is decorated with Angels. You can take an Angel and return it with a gift card. This will be a Christmas present for one of our neighbors in need.

We thank you for your past and continuous assistance. We are especially grateful to those who helped us during the pandemic, enabling us to continue our ministry during that awful period.
