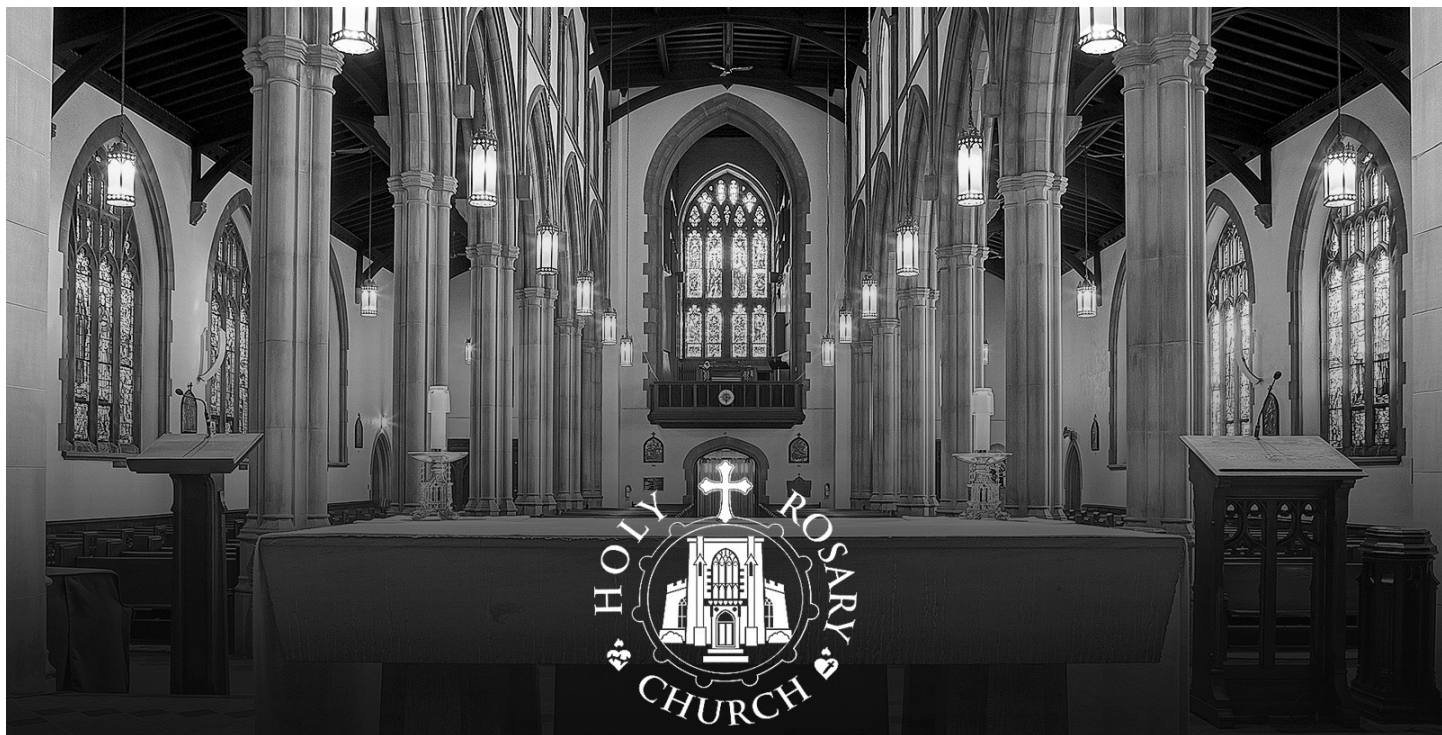

Please remember that on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent, everyone aged 14 and up must abstain from consuming meat. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, everyone 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to usually a medical reason.

This is a privileged time to pray, fast and increase our almsgiving with the expressed desire to repent of our sins and grow in intimacy with the Crucified Saviour.

5. Beginning Friday, February 24th, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 6:20 PM. Mass will be celebrated at 7 PM followed by our weekly spiritual reflection on the Eucharist. Please join us for this important Lenten devotional.
