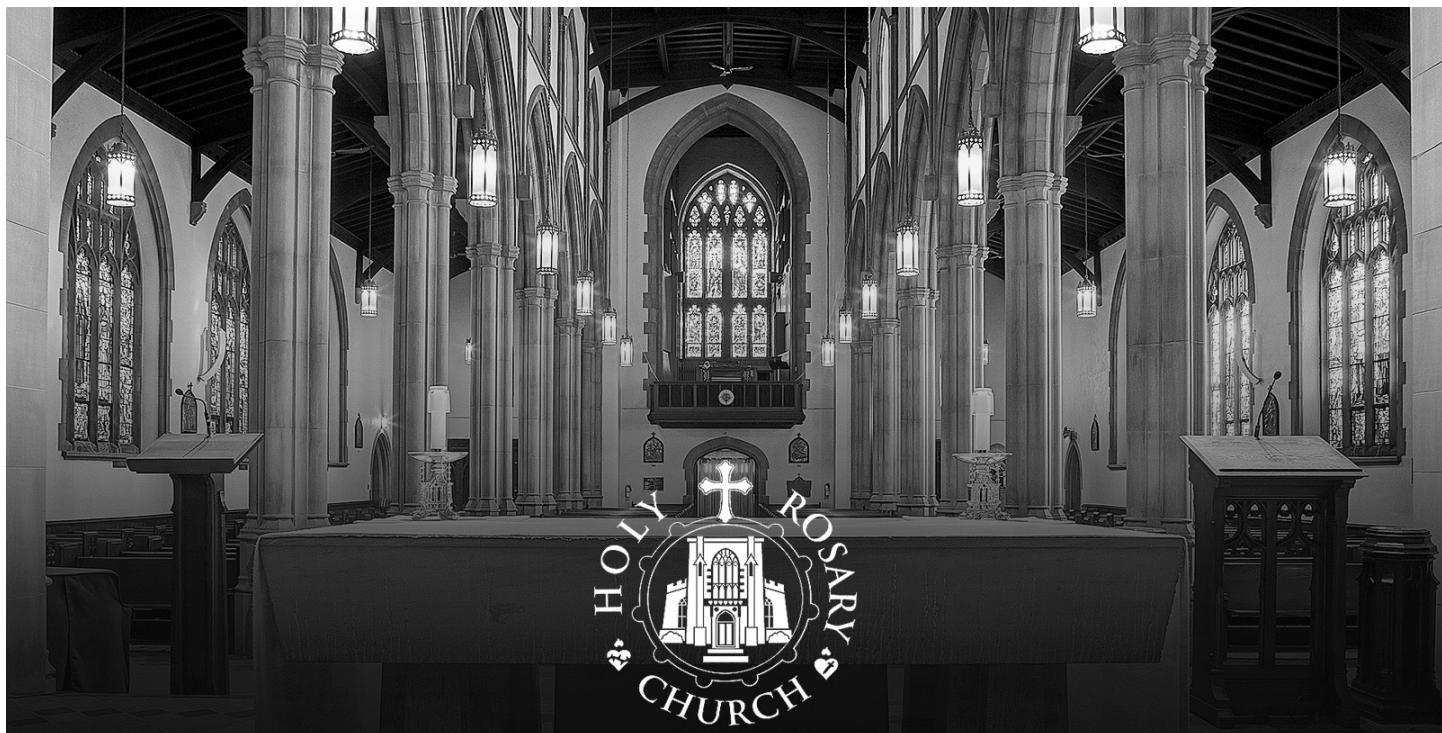

The Apostolate of the Shrine of the Immaculate Heart of Mary will be presented in our parish on the weekend of May 20/21 by the Heralds of the Gospel. It aims to promote the Rosary in Reparation to Our Lady for the offenses She receives from mankind, for the conversion of sinners, and for the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary to come as soon as possible.
