5. At 7 PM on Tuesday March 21st, we will hold an evening for the sacrament of reconciliation. We will begin with a scriptural reading and examination of conscience, followed by an opportunity for individual confessions. This is in addition to our regular daily

confessions offered before each Mass. Please note, all Catholics are required to go to confession at least once per year.

7. Please join us for the Solemnity of the Annunciation of Our Lord on Saturday, March 25th. We begin with the rosary at 8:30 AM, 9 AM Solemn Mass followed by a Holy Hour. During this time we will be praying in a special way for our new Archbishop, His Grace, Frank Leo, who begins his new ministry on that day.

8. The installation of Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo as Archbishop of Toronto will take place on Saturday, March 25th at 10 AM. Given capacity restrictions at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, this will be an invitation-only event. The Apostolate of the Shrine of the Immaculate Heart of Mary will be presented in our parish on the



weekend of May 20/21 by the Heralds of the Gospel. It aims to promote the Rosary in Reparation to Our Lady for the offenses. She receives from mankind, for the conversion of sinners, and for the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of

Mary to come as soon as possible. This Apostolate started with a blessing of St. John Paul II in the year 2001 and is now spread to over 70 countries.
