

## 5. Finance Council Update

The Finance Council has reviewed the Holy Rosary Church first quarter financial results for the three-month period ended March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. We are pleased to report that Weekly Offertory revenue has increased +26% vs. Q1 2022. We are heartened by the response of our parish community to our appeals for support in restoring our finances to a sustainable operating income surplus position. Keeping the weekly offertory improvement as this level for the remainder of the year will go a long way to achieving our goal. Expenses in the quarter were controlled very close to the budget, resulting in a strong start to our fiscal year. The Finance Council will publish a detailed 6-month financial report to parishioners later in the summer.

Thank you to all of you who have increased your weekly offertory and/or have moved to automatic monthly giving via credit card or pre-authorized debit. As we enter the summer vacation and cottage season, we ask you to consider moving to automatic monthly giving so that Holy Rosary can count on regular monthly offertory revenue. If you prefer to continue using envelopes, please consider topping up your envelope donations to cover the period where you might be away on vacation or at the cottage. We need to maintain our improved pace of offertory revenues, and continue to carefully manage expenses, to achieve our desired year-end surplus operating income position.
