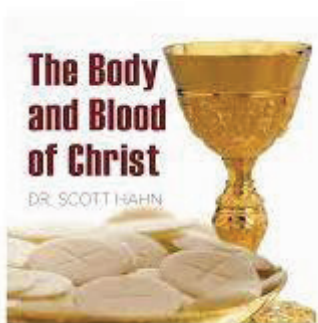

your generosity to help support the most vulnerable in our community. Thank you for your support.

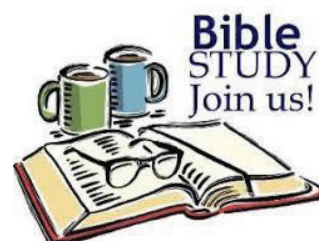
4. The **JUNE** Food of the Month donation is **BAGS OF QUINOA OR COUSCOUS**.
