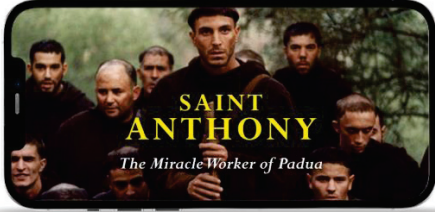

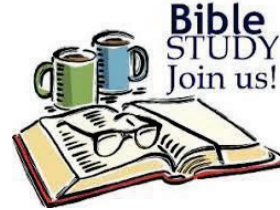
2. The **JUNE** Food of the Month donation is **BAGS OF QUINOA OR COUSCOUS**.
