2. Holy Rosary Building Committee – Refinishing the Church Doors

One of the projects that the Building Committee has scheduled for this year is to refinish the Church and Rectory doors. You may well be wondering why the doors need refinishing again after only 3 years after they were done as part of the major renovations to the church; unfortunately, a very poor job was done at that time which has resulted in us having to do them again, this time with a different contractor with excellent references.



This work will begin shortly with doors being removed sequentially and taken to the shop for any needed repairs and refinishing. While each pair of doors is being refinished, that doorway will be closed off with plywood so you will have to use other church entrances. The only exceptions to this will be the northeast door on Tweedsmuir Ave. which will have

temporary, operable doors installed to maintain a barrier-free entrance; and, of course, the Rectory door will also have to be operable.

We hope this won't inconvenience you too much, but this type of work cannot be done properly on site; it must be done in a shop. Thank you for your patience.

3. Holy Rosary Hall Development Committee

Many of you may be wondering what has been happening with the project to redevelop our Parish Hall site. The project was begun because our hall is in poor physical shape and, in many respects, does not satisfy our Parish needs but we do not have the funds to either bring the facility up to modern standards or build a new hall. The plan is to sell the land on which the hall stands for residential development and use the proceeds to build a new hall and provide a reserve fund for the maintenance of our beautiful church.

By last Fall, we had made a great deal of progress in detailing the needs of the Parish and developing potential designs for the new facilities; we have also completed the necessary environmental surveys of the property with satisfactory results. We had expected to approach the development industry before the end of 2022 to get expressions of interest. However, the rapid rise in interest rates during the last half of 2022 has caused many developers to pause their activities until they have a better understanding of where the real estate market is heading. On the advice of our consultants, we have decided to postpone any approaches to the developers at least until this Fall when we will again evaluate the environment.

The good news is that our consultants still believe that the site, with its proximity to the subway, is a strong candidate for redevelopment; it's very much a matter of timing.
