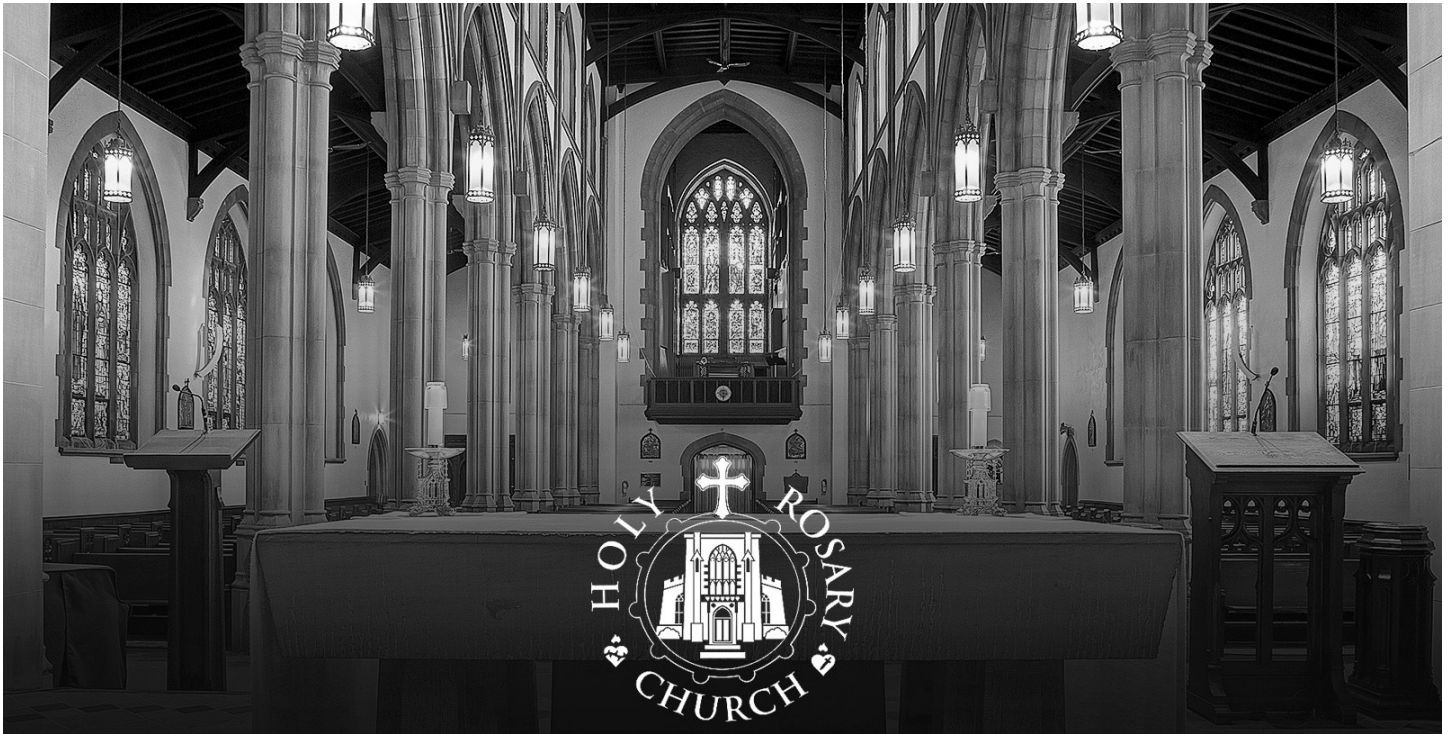

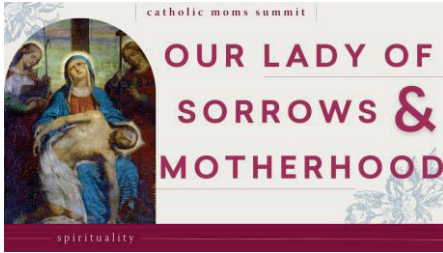
## SACRAMENT OF THE SICK AND CARE FOR THE ELDERLY & SHUT-INS
