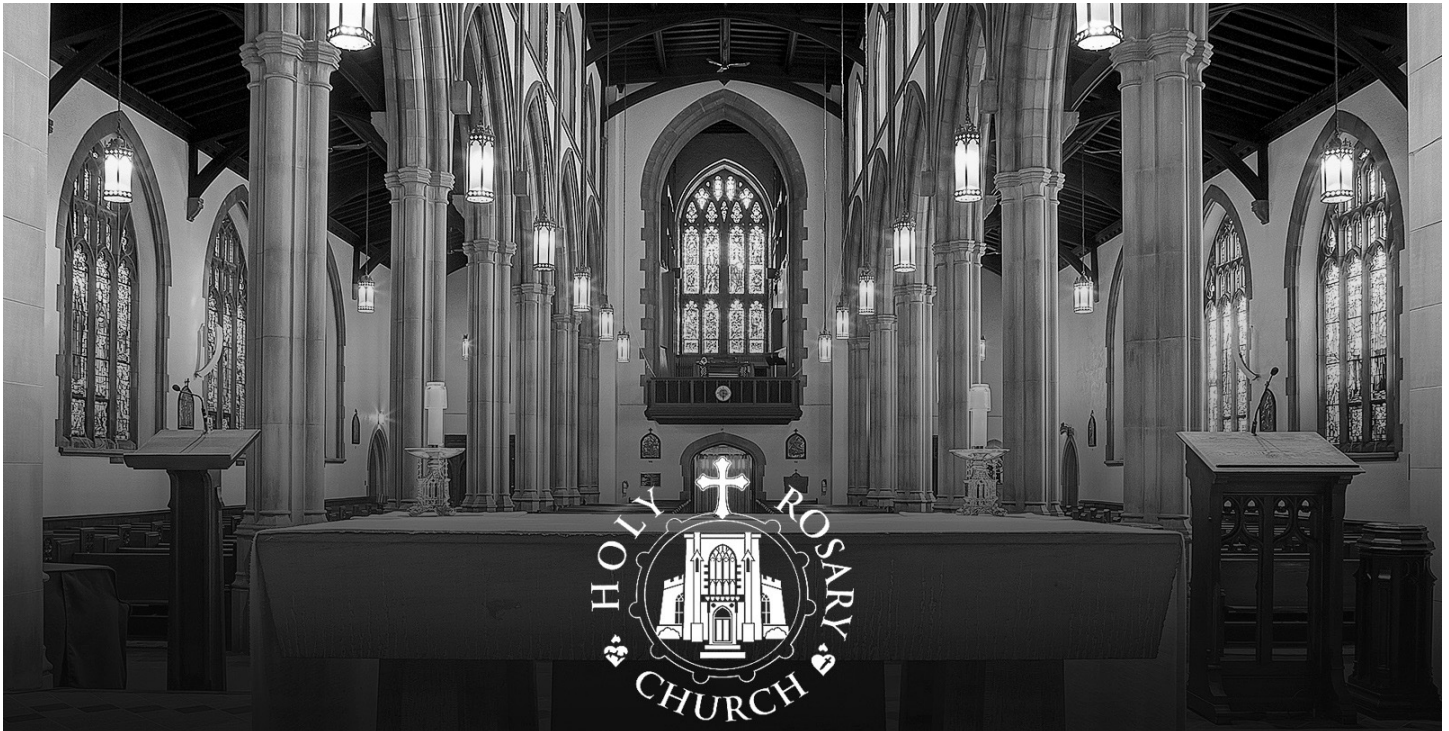

### The Bible Timeline: The Story of Salvation
