For those we love,

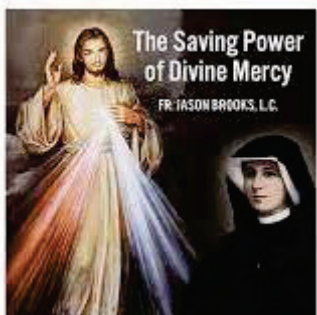
For all things sent
