

5. ShareLife recently allocated \$620,000 to support food and meal programs across the archdiocese. With many people facing difficulty obtaining this necessity of life, the ShareLife Advisory Board wanted to help to address this issue. We worked with Catholic Charities and the St. Vincent de Paul to distribute these funds to agencies and parishes in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

The issue of food security is prominent today in our society. One in ten people in Toronto are now turning to a food bank for help. Overall, almost 33% of people using a food bank are under 17 and 43% between 18 and 44.



The Churches-on-the-Hill program received \$40,000 from ShareLife through the St. Vincent de Paul for the food bank program. We trust that these funds will help to support the work of your parish communities to provide food to those in need. We are pleased to be able to support this program supported by your parishes to help those in need and thank you again for all that you are doing for ShareLife!
