The Pastor's Reflection

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." (John 3:15)

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord:

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Gospel focuses on a hidden dialogue between Nicodemus and Jesus. Nicodemus is a Pharisee and leader of the Jews, most likely a member of the Sanhedrin. From a Catholic perspective, he would have been similar to a cardinal at the Vatican. All eyes would have been on him. Jesus is performing many signs and preaching with an authority never before seen or heard. John tells us he comes to Jesus at night out of fear of being noticed by the other religious authorities. He is afraid of what they will think of him. The Evangelist is also telling us that Nicodemus is still in spiritual darkness. He needs the Holy Spirit in order for him to be "born again" (Jn 3:3). He cannot enter the "Kingdom of God" unless he first gets baptized (Jn 3:3). It is only then that he will come to understand the truth ofJesus Christ.

Jesus tells Nicodemus that "as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life" (Jn 3:14). In the Book of Numbers, the sacred author recounts how the Israelites sinned against God by constantly complaining about their lack of sufficient food and water. They failed to trust in Divine Providence. Consequently, they were punished through the arrival of fiery serpents which bite the people and ultimately killed them (cf. Num 21:4-9). As a consequence of their repentance, God commanded that Moses put a serpent on a pole and have everyone who had been bitten look upon it for healing. The thing that caused their death was now the very thing that caused their healing!

"God, who is rich in mercy," sent Jesus to die for our sins (Eph 2:4). Those of us who look upon Christ Crucified with repentant eyes will be forgiven of our sins because he came "not to condemn but that the world might be saved through him" (Jn 3: 17). Look upon the Lord and be saved! Look upon the wounds Jesus accepted out of love for us and repent! Hide yourself in those wounds and pray that the Sacred Blood that flowed from them will wash you clean and renew your spirit! Like the "princes of Judah, the priests and people" of old, we too have been unfaithful to the Lord (2 Chr 36:14). That is why we fast, pray, and give alms during Lent. That is why we make an extra effort to go to Sacramental Confession before the arrival of Holy Week. We ask him to wash away the dirt from our souls so that we can be found clean and ready to do the "good works" God wants from each one of us! (Eph 2:10).
