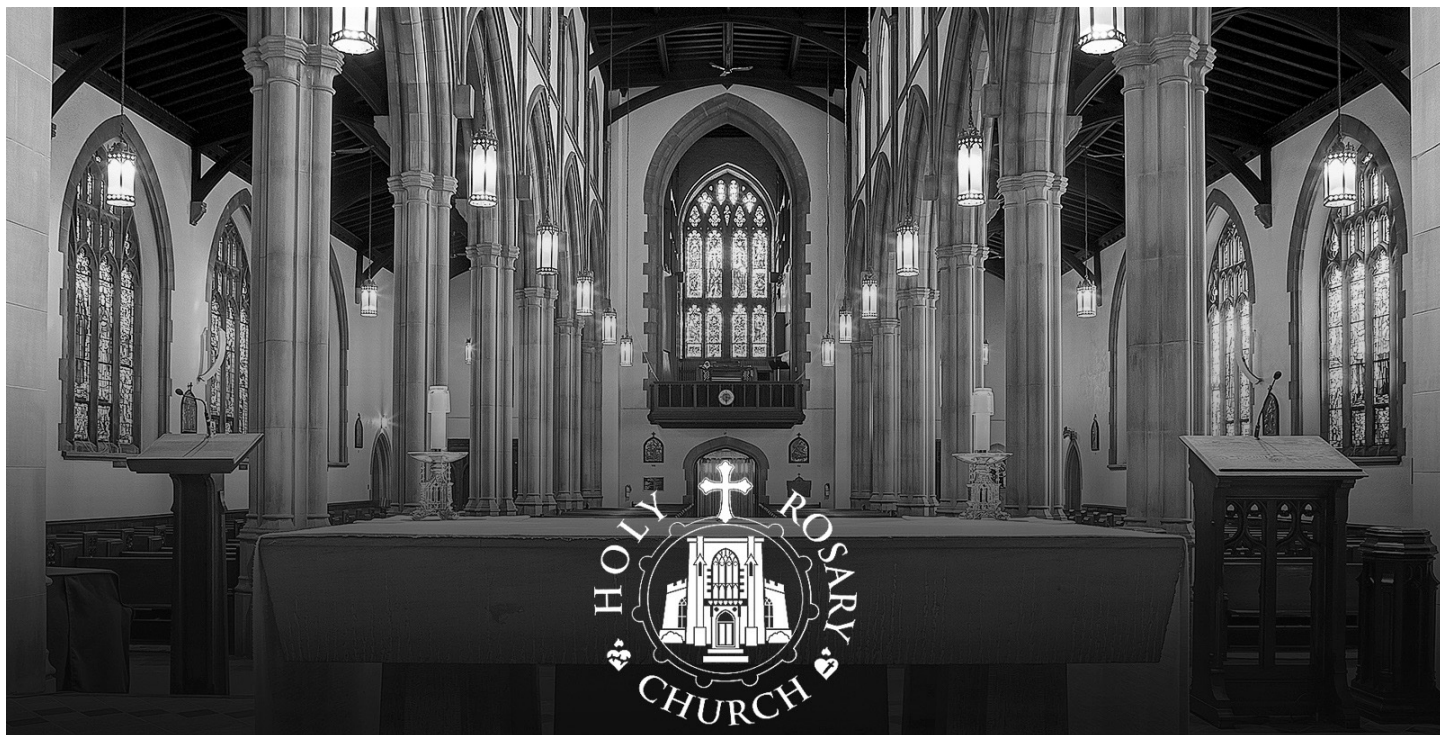

*"See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good."*  
(Psalm 53.6,8)



## The Pastor's Reflection

*"When he disembarked and saw the crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd' and he began to teach them*

*many things."* (Mk 6:33-4)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

The Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen often said that "it is better to burn out rather than rust out." Many people may be shocked by such words, especially in today's society where the cult of self-care has become a new religion. Another great saint, Teresa of Avila, used to remind her nuns to "not confuse true needs with mere desires". Neither of these saints were considered rigid and sour-faced. In fact, the opposite was true.

Their love for God and people filled them with an incredible sense of joy. During the process of her canonization, St. Teresa's religious sisters commented on how her laughter could be heard throughout the entire convent. Archbishop Sheen had an incredible sense of humour and special love for the poor. He funded hospitals, churches and schools all around the world. Similar to Christ in today's Gospel, St. Teresa and Archbishop Sheen's service towards others moved them to go beyond their comfort levels and learn to place others first.

The apostles experienced fatigue. Jesus is exhausted. There is barely time to eat and sleep. As they look forward to rest, the Lord sees a crowd of people desperately waiting for help. How do the disciples react? Did they complain? "Tell them to wait!" "Don't they realize that we need a break?" There reactions would have been completely understandable. The Gospels are filled with these types of complaints coming from the lips of the Twelve. The evangelist Mark informs us that Jesus "was moved with compassion for them." (Mk 6:33). Jesus sets aside his own legitimate needs for the sake of others.

Are we able to do the same? Or do we guard our personal time with all our might? All of us need time for rest. The summer is a perfect time to do so. True rest involves longer periods of prayer, and meditation on God's word and enjoying creation. Serving others is also a wonderful means of discovering true joy; we were created for this purpose. Let us ask God to grant us the grace to learn to rest, but never too much that we refuse help to those in need.

## Announcements

1. We no longer have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after Mass each Monday.

2. Next weekend, at all masses, Rev. Raju Pilla will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. Trivandrum has about 2,70,000 Catholics. 90% of the people belongs to fishermen community, majority of whom depends on fishing for their livelihood. 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in the communities. The archdiocese depends on outside contributions to support its clergy, seminarians, catechists, and the humanitarian projects of the homes for the orphans, aged and destitute, which provide food, shelter, health care, and education. In 2021, Hurricane "Taufae" left hundreds of families homeless. Monsoon sea-erosion each year, destroys several homes of the fishermen who live near the sea and make a living from fishing. The archdiocese is yet to recover from the crippling effects of financial devastation caused by the pandemic lockdowns. We humbly request your generous contribution to the second collection for the Mission Co-op next weekend, July 27/28. Your sacrifice for the Missions is deeply appreciated.
