FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

"Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast." (Cf Isaiah 66.10-11)



"Do you believe in the Son of Man?" He answered, "And who is that sir, that I may believe in him" Jesus said to him, "You have seen him, it is he who speaks to you. "Lord, I believe", and he worshipped him" (Jn 9:35-38)

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord:

This week's Gospel presents us with the moving episode of the healing of the man born blind. Jesus notices him as he walks. Nothing escapes his merciful glance. Then, the Lord takes some of his own spittle and dust to form mud, with which he covers the man's eyes. Why spittle? Most of Jesus' miracles took place with him saying a word. In ancient times, spittle was considered to be a possible cure for blindness. Yet more than that, Adam was made from the dust of the earth (c.f. Gen 2:7). Adam sinned and lost the grace of God. Both Adam and Eve became spiritually blind.

The new Adam, Jesus Christ, came to renew creation. The Son of Man came to restore the blindness of humanity. In this case, the healing took place on two levels. First, the blind man could physically see for the first time in his life. Second, he could spiritually see that the man talking to him was the Messiah.

I know of several people who regained their physical sight through a true miracle! Today, we need more than ever to have our spiritual sight restored. Many contemporary men and women believe that they are awake and have clear vision. Many are blind. How can anyone claim to know what is true, good and beautiful without Jesus Christ, "the Light of the world?" The further away we move from him the deeper our blindness.

Don't be afraid of Jesus Christ. He loves you and wants to heal you and he calls us to live as "children of the light" (Eph 5:9). St Paul tells us we need to "learn what is pleasing to the Lord" and to put it into practice (cf. Eph 5:10).
