## FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

"When he calls on me, I will answer him; I will deliver him and give him glory, I will grant him length of days." (Cf Psalm 90. 15-16)



"Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Holy Spirit in the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing at all during those

days, and when they were over, he was famished." (Lk 4:1-2)

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord:

The Holy Spirit led Jesus to be tempted by who? Satan? Why would the Third Person of the Holy Trinity do such a thing to the God-Man, Jesus Christ? It's very simple! Adam fell when tempted. Jesus, the new Adam, came to resist temptation and show us how to win.

Jesus was exhausted and famished after 40 days without food. He was incredibly vulnerable, and it was then that the devil came to attack. How typical of the devil.!! Yet, Jesus does not fall. Jesus is the author of Scripture and leans on His Written Word to resist. The devil keeps trying to lure Jesus but fails miserably. The Lord refuses to veer from the mission His Father entrusted to him. Jesus was also thinking about us.

When we are tempted, do we lean on Scripture? Do we think about how our actions will affect our spouse, children, friends, congregations? We were created for heaven, not hell. Choose life, choose Jesus, and he will give us everything necessary to win. Fast, pray and give alms. Engage in these winning actions each day, do not hold back. Our experience of Easter joy will be largely determined by our willingness to engage in the spiritual battle against the flesh, the world and the devil.

In contrast to the emotion of happiness, Christian Joy, as a gift and a fruit of the Holy Spirit, is always available and is based on our acceptance






