FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

On this Fourth Sunday of Easter, we are invited to reflect upon the sublime reality of belonging to Jesus Christ. Imagine that? The God of all that is seen, and unseen knows who you and I are personally. He knows us inside out. The truth of who we are; both the good and bad. He knows our name (c.f. Ps 91:14), how many hairs we have on our heads (c.f. Lk 12:7), he knows the circumstances of our conception, life and death (c.f. Ps 139). He knows all the choices we have, are and will make in the future. He is outside of time and sees our past, present and future all at once.

Some people will object to these truths and declare that we have a free will. However, this is an untruth. Seeing someone do something does not mean that you are the cause of their decision. Jesus says that his sheep listen to his voice and follow him. Amidst the cacophony of voices in our world today, it is easy to become confused and lost. Jesus is the way, the truth and the life (Jn 14:6).

When we prayerfully read the Gospel, go to Mass and listen to the homily, pray at home and learn what the Church teaches us, we are listening to God's voice and will therefore never become confused or lost. We will always follow Jesus who leads us into his Kingdom, which is not of this world (c.f. Jn 18:36). What a gift to know that by being faithful to Jesus in this life, we will be with him in the life to come. May each of us cherish this knowledge and may it lead us to an ever-deepening love and trust in our Good Shepherd.

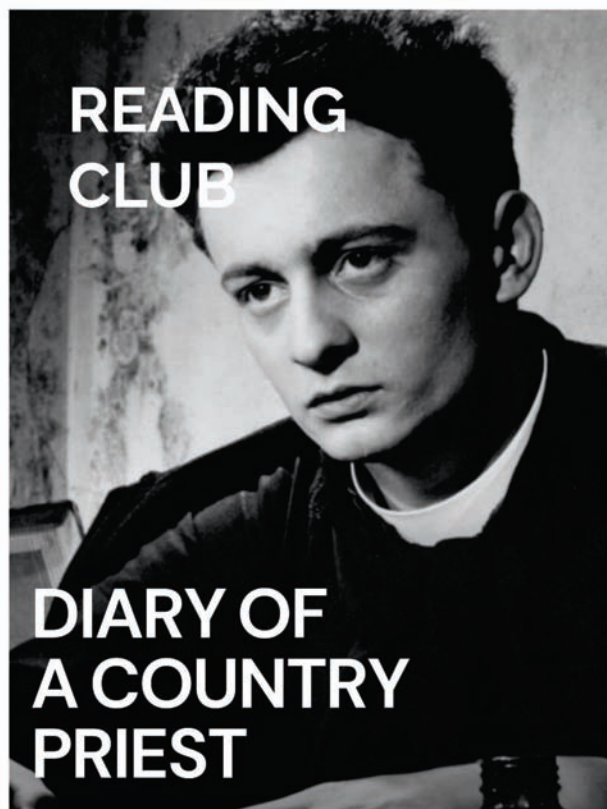
2. The Parish will have our annual Pentecost Party on **Sunday, June 8th, from 1 PM to 3 PM**. Join us for
