THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

"Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia." (Acts 1.11)



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Today, we celebrate Christ's ascension into heaven. Luke tells us that "while they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud

took him from their sight." (Acts 1:11). Jesus' departure comes with a promise that he will send the Holy Spirit to rest upon the apostles and all who will work with them in giving testimony and spreading the faith throughout the entire world.

Most of us have yet to understand the importance of the ascension. Isn't it enough that Jesus was resurrected from the dead?

Pope St Leo the Great provides a clear and powerful answer to this question. According to this holy pope, "our poor human nature was carried up, in Christ, above all the hosts of heaven, above all the ranks of angels, beyond the heavenly powers to the very throne of God the Father." Everything that God did on earth gets taken up and glorified in the presence of the Heavenly Father. All that is good, true, and beautiful about our earthly lives will be recalled. At the Second Coming of Christ, all will be remembered and glorified.

Moreover, Jesus' earthly presence passes into the sacraments. Everyone, no matter where you are on earth, or in space, or no matter whether you lived in 33 AD or will live in 15,000 AD, will have a direct encounter with the Risen Lord through them. How can we not rejoice knowing this?


