# THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

"Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love."



"We cannot wrap our arms around the ocean, but we can enter into it. We cannot encompass the mystery of the Trinity with our minds, but we can enter into it!" Raniero Cardinal Cantalamessa

Dear brothers and sisters in

Christ:

151 - 2

Today is Trinity Sunday! God is one, in three Persons. We know this as a matter of fact because Jesus revealed this to us. The Old Testament is replete with subtle references to the Trinity that are later made explicit in the New Testament. At first, it can seem confusing. How can God be one in Three? Yet, St John tells us that God is love (1 Jn 4:8). God is not solitary. God is a communion of persons. In order for him to be love itself, there must be someone to love. The Father loves the Son, and the Son loves the Father. The love between the two is the Holy Spirit. They differ in their relations to one another. Perhaps this sounds too theoretical. It need not be. St Paul tells us that "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us" at baptism (Rm 5:5). The Trinity comes to live inside of us.

In a letter written just a few weeks before her death, St Elizabeth of the Trinity declared to a friend: "My beloved Antoinette, I leave you my faith in the presence of God, of the God who is all Love dwelling in our souls. I confide to you: it is this intimacy with Him 'within' that has been the beautiful sun illuminating my life, making it already an anticipated Heaven."

Brothers and sisters, I urge you to meditate on these beautiful words so that they may give you peace in the midst of the joys and sorrows of everyday life. We are not alone, God lives inside of us!




