Dear brothers and sisters: Happy Feast of Corpus Christi!

St. John Vianney taught that there is no greater gift than the Eucharist. How blessed we are as Catholics to be able to receive the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ, even daily! So why don't all Catholics come to Mass each Sunday? Tragically, more than half of all baptized Catholics do not believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. They only see it as a symbol. How can this be? The apostles and their successors have always taught that the Eucharist is really and truly Jesus Christ as he is in heaven. I encourage you to log onto <u>formed.org</u> and watch the series on the Eucharist entitled Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist. This will help you to understand the great gift handed unto us from Christ himself.

Pope Benedict XVI once wrote that, unlike the food we eat, which is broken down, digested, and later becomes part of our body, we become part of Jesus' body when we receive Him in Communion. May who we consume transform us into himself. May he bring healing, virtue, and holiness in our lives as we continue on in this journey of life.
