From the Pastor

151 - 2

There was a scholar of the law who stood up to test Jesus and said, "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus said to him, "What is written in the law? How do you read it?" He said in reply, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being,

with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbour as yourself." He replied to him, "You have answered correctly; do this and you will live." (Lk 10:25-30)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

The scholar of the law asked an excellent question. He wanted to know how to get to heaven. Interestingly, he was a scholar of the law, and yet he was still confused. After Jesus prompts him, the scholar provides the correct answer. Love God above everything and one's neighbour as oneself.

It is not very complicated! And yet, we make it so difficult. Even the scholar is dissatisfied with the Lord's response, and he requests clarification on who would be considered a neighbour. Is it our family member, next door neighbour, the colleague in our office, the person sitting next to us in the pew, the homeless person on the street who is always begging for money? The answer is simple: everyone!

The Lord continues and tells us that we are called to do good to our enemies, too. Jesus reminds us that it is the Samaritan who was the only one who helped the man who had been attacked by robbers. We know the Samaritan was the enemy because he was coming down from Jerusalem. The Samaritans refused to worship in Jerusalem and tried to prevent the Jews from rebuilding their Temple. Thus, there was a great deal of animosity between them.

Anyone who thinks Christianity is an escape from reality is deeply deluded. Our Lord and Saviour himself challenges us as followers to do the most difficult things. He seeks to pull us outside of ourselves. All of this will only happen if we first love the Lord. May God grant us the strength to be who he wants us to be men and women who show mercy towards others (cf. Lk 10:37)
