# FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

*"Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice."*

(Cf. Psalm 47. 10-11)



*"The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest."* (Lk 10:2)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

During the Papal Audience on June 25th, 2025, His Holiness Pope Leo XIV said the following: "A very widespread ailment of our time is the fatigue of living: reality seems to us too complex, burdensome, difficult to face. So we switch off, we fall asleep, in the delusion that upon waking, things will be different. But reality has to be faced, and together with Jesus, we can do it well." How do the Holy Father's comments relate to Jesus' words in today's Gospel?

Jesus is sending 70 additional disciples ahead of him to prepare the way for his arrival. They are missionaries. When they arrive at a town, they are to look around, speak to the people, acquire a feel for how they live, learn about their hopes and concerns, and understand their faith traditions. Once the disciples understand the temperament of the townspeople, they may introduce Jesus to them. When Jesus arrives with the Good News, the townspeople will understand him.

Pope Leo is affirming to us that we have a responsibility to share our faith with others. Looking at many of our cities and towns, we too see people who are oppressed, confused, and tired of living. As Catholics, we are called to share the Good News with people. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life (Jn 14:6). He is the Good Shepherd who has come to heal and transform us into children of God.

We are called to "comfort" others with this experiential knowledge of the goodness of the Lord (cf. Is 66:13). To comfort someone means to be with them in their suffering and to offer them real hope. How many of us have been recipients of good people who have helped us out during various trials in our lives? They have shared our burden and helped us to see the light.

Let us ask the Lord to inspire all of us to become like the 70 in today's Gospel. In fact, let us pray to the Lord and request a dramatic increase in holy vocations to the priesthood, and religious and consecrated life that is wholly committed to comforting God's people.
