

Weekly Biblical Reflection

If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple.

Dear brothers and sisters:

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us of the man building a house, and then of an army commander heading into battle. In both cases, it would be wise to ensure that one has enough resources for the intended task. Jesus concludes with: "...anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple." Am I the only one confused by Jesus' words?

What is it that you are trying to accomplish in this life? From Jesus' parable, the man building the house and the army commander entering into battle are metaphors for the spiritual life: the Kingdom of God must be built with diligent labour, and we must contend with the envious attacks of the enemy. However, there is the danger of becoming too drawn to the shiny tools and weapons with which God equips us for our task. People, places, and things can be very attractive, yet they are mere reflections of the Goodness of God, but not God Himself. If we place all our hope of contentment on people, places, and material items, we come face-to-face with that God-sized vacuum in our heart that screams out for more.

When I was in the seventh grade, our teacher showed us a video of a man trying to fill a glass jar with rocks and sand. His goal was to include both rocks and sand in the jar, without leaving anything out. He poured all of the sand into the jar, and as he moved on to the rocks, we quickly realized that there was not enough room for both in the jar. Bewildered by the dilemma, I watched the man remove the rocks and pour the sand back out, telling the audience that he would try another way. This time, he put in the large rocks first, and then he was able to easily pour in all the sand and fill in the crevices, just like water.

Let us reflect on the people, places, or things that we prioritize over God, those bits of sand that we place in our jar first, only to find insufficient room for what matters most: eternal union with our Creator and our Father. We may accept this as true, but in practice, it is very difficult; indeed, it is a Cross to carry. I thank

Jesus for taking up His Cross first. By His example, we see that those who make do with very little, after renouncing all the goods of this earth, yes, even their own life, are the ones most resourceful and most successful at accomplishing their task.


