Weekly Biblical Reflection

"Jesus spoke to his disciples. 'If your brother or sister sins against you, go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If he or she listens to you, you have regained your brother or sister.'" (Mat 18:15)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

One of Jesus' more challenging commands relates to fraternal correction. The quote above, taken from today's Gospel reading, explains the essence of fraternal correction. According to the Catholic Encyclopedia, fraternal correction is an act of charity where we may practice the spiritual work of mercy of admonishing the sinner.[1] In today's Gospel passage, Jesus is instructing the disciples on how to live as brothers and sisters within the faith community. When speaking of fraternal correction, notice that Jesus does not say, "go and tell everyone except the person who has sinned against you." Many of us are afraid to have difficult conversations with others, even those closest to us. We may have been deeply offended by someone and yet, out of fear, reluctant to bring it to their attention. As a result of our silence, the pain may fester within, leading us to become bitter and lose our peace. Instead of an honest conversation with the person who hurt us, we often tell other people, which can become sinful rather than cathartic.

In these situations, what are we to do? First, pray that Jesus will send the Holy Spirit to help us to speak to our brother or sister who has offended us; everything should be reviewed in prayer and with a spirit of humility. Second, let us examine our conscience. Is the situation really serious? Or is it a matter of our wounded pride? Let us have the courage to answer these questions honestly. Finally, if there is a real offence present, then we should meet with the person privately and one-to-one. If an in-person or phone conversation is too difficult, perhaps consider sending an email. It is a good practice to wait at least 24 hours before responding. Angry emails or texts sent in the height of intense emotions are always a very bad idea!

In your email or during the conversation, tell the person what has happened and how their behaviour has made you feel. It is often the case that others do not even realize that what they have done (or are doing) is problematic. Never attack the other person's character; instead, explain to them how their actions or words have hurt you. Offer them the chance to explain their perspective. Pray before, during, and after the conversation. Ask their Guardian Angel to help the person to be open to what you are trying to communicate. Finally, accept that your attempt to fraternally correct a brother or sister may or may not be effective in bringing about a change in their behaviour. The outcome is less important than the knowledge that, in the end, you will have

made the effort to live the Gospel in this particular situation. Only the Lord knows if and when the person will repent (cf. Ezek 33:9).
